Disc Golf is played just like golf but a disc is used instead of balls and clubs. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The goal is to play each hole in the fewest strokes possible. The player with the lowest total strokes for the entire course wins.

OBJECT: Have fun and play the course from beginning to end with the fewest throws. **TEE OFF:** The first shot of the hole must be made from the concrete pads. **LIE:** The spot where the disc lands on a player's previous throw. **THROWING:** The player with the least amount of strokes on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first. You must throw from where your disc lands. **COURTESY:** Do not throw the disc if there are golfers at the next basket in which you are throwing at. **COMPLETING A HOLE:** A disc that comes to rest in the basket or chains constitutes a successful completion of that hole.
